### **Are you Covered?**

Pacific Northwest Tattoo Seminars and Lady Luck Tattoo Studio does not carry accident insurance for program participants. Please review your own personal health insurance plan to be certain that you and your family have the proper coverage.

### **Information for Students on Use of Social Security Numbers**

Why am I being asked for my social security number?

This Washington State licensed private vocational school is required by state law (see WAC 490-105-160) to ask for your social security number, as well as your ethnicity, date of birth, education prior to enrollment, name, address and phone number. Whether or not a student provides their social security number is voluntary. The school reports this information to the Workforce Training and Education Coordinating Board (WTECB) - the state agency that licenses and monitors private vocational schools.

Why does WTECB collect social security numbers:

WTECB uses social security numbers for research and evaluation purposes. In order to evaluate how well a school is preparing students for the workforce, WTECB tracks the employment and earning of graduates. This is done by matching student-reported social security numbers with the social security numbers in the wage records kept by the state Employment Security Department, to determine whether or not students are employed and what they are earning after they leave a school. No names are attached to the social security numbers during the matching process. No individual data appears in the final reports of each school's employment rate and average earnings.

What security measures are taken with student information?

WTECB is required to keep individually identifiable information confidential. WTECB is protected by law from being required to disclose individually identifiable information as public information. WTECB will not disclose it to anyone except authorized WTECB employees or contractors working on specific research and evaluation activities. Those employees or contractor are bound by confidentiality agreements. All hard copies and diskettes containing data are kept in locked temporary storage and destroyed when data are no longer needed for analysis. WTECB encrypts the social security numbers stored in electronic data files as a further measure of protection.
