POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Firefighter

REPORTS TO: Station Captain or Station Lieutenant

ADOPTED: January 14, 2009 (Revised)

1.0 POSITION PURPOSE:

Position is responsible for responding to incidents within their station area with fire apparatus.

2.0 TYPICAL DUTIES:

Responsible for maintaining good morale among fellow firefighters.

Respond to appropriate incidents in their area with their fire apparatus and assume command until relieved by an officer of higher authority.

Refer all official matters to the Station Captain or Station Lieutenant.

Periodically inspect and maintain the fire station, observing the apparatus, equipment and general condition of the station.

Perform training duties as assigned.

Perform such other duties as the Station Captain, Station Lieutenant or Chief may deem necessary.

Acquire a thorough knowledge of the physical conditions throughout the District and first alarm areas. Such knowledge shall include: structural conditions of buildings, extra ordinary hazardous, locations and functions of fire fighting systems and water supplies available for fire extinguishment.

Carry a pager whenever in the District.

Acquire a thorough knowledge of the duties of this position and to adhere to the Volunteer Membership Requirements. (Policy #20-5)

If a witness, or observer, of an emergency incident involving fire, rescue or medical aid, within the boundaries of Spokane County Fire District #3, or within the limits of any jurisdiction with which our agency has a mutual aid contract, shall be obligated to stop and render appropriate assistance to the best of their ability.

### 3.0 REQUIREMENTS:

High School graduate or equivalent and 18 years old.

Applicant must possess a valid drivers license.

Ability to function under pressure.

Must complete Recruit Class.
